21	'Further amend the bill in section 6 by striking out all of
23	paragraph D and inserting in its place the following:
25	'D. When segregation exceeds 24 hours, the chief administrative officer of the correctional facility shall
27	cause the facility's physician or a member of the facility's medical staff to visit the person forthwith immediately and,
29	at least once in each succeeding 24-hour period of confinement, to examine the person's state of health. When
31	no physician or medical staff member is available within the facility to visit as required by this paragraph, a staff
33	person who has received in-service training appropriate for the duties required by this section from a licensed health
35	professional shall visit in lieu of the visit by the physician or medical staff member the person in
37	confinement. The staff person making the visit shall immediately contact the physician or medical staff member on
39	<u>call if there is reasonable cause to believe the action is</u> necessary.
41	(1) The chief administrative officer shall give full
43	consideration to recommendations of the physician or medical staff member as to the person's dietary needs
45	and the conditions of the person's confinement required to maintain his that person's health.
47	(2) If the recommendations of the physician or medical
49	staff member regarding a person's dietary or other health needs while in segregation are not carried out,
51	the chief administrative officer shall immediately convey the reasons and circumstances for this decision
