23	§601. Approval of legislation
25	When approval of legislation by an Indian tribe or Indian
27	nation is required by the United States Code, Title 25, Section 1725(e), or other act of Congress, certification of that approval
29	shall be made to the Secretary of State by the officer of the affected Indian tribe or Indian nation designated in section 602
31	or 603. The certification shall state the date and manner of approval of the legislation and shall be prima facie evidence of
	approval. The Secretary of State shall forthwith transmit
33	certified copies of the certification of approval to the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of
35	Representatives.'
37	Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3
39	and inserting in its place the following:
	'Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall be effective only if:
11	1. The United States enacts legislation:
13	A. Ratifying and approving this Act without modification;

<u>1</u> 7	B. Providing the consent of the United States for amendments to this Act, with respect to the Aroostook Band

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	2. Within 60 days of adjournment of the Legislature, the
3	Secretary of State receives written certification by the Council of the Aroostook Band of Micmacs that the band has agreed to
5	this Act, copies of which shall be submitted by the Secretary of State to the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House
7	of Representatives, provided that in no event shall this Act become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
9	Legislature.'
11	Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

15	STATEMENT OF FACT
17	
19	This amendment adds sections that were inadvertently omitted from the bill.
21	The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 601 is amended to clarify that the Aroostook Band of Micmacs must consent to any
23	amendments of this implementing Act once Congress passes legislation to that effect.
25	The effective date section is amended to require the
27	Aroostook Band of Micmacs to approve this Act or this Act will not become effective. This is standard language governing

approval of legislation by the affected Indian nation, tribe or

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band.
