13	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " ^A " to S.P. 154, L.D. 274, Bill, "An Act to Permit Law Enforcement Officers to Solicit Funds for a Law
15	Enforcement Officers' Memorial"
17	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place
19	the following:
21	'Sec. 1. Solicitation for a slain law enforcement officers' memorial. For one year following the effective date of this Act, the
23	prohibition on solicitation under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 25, section 3702, shall not apply to persons authorized
25	under section 2 of this Act to solicit funds for the payment of or to pay for any obligations incurred in the completion,
27	erection and maintenance of one memorial to commemorate law enforcement officers slain in the line of duty, to be erected at
29	a location selected by the Maine Chiefs of Police Association.
31	Sec. 2. Persons authorized to solicit. The following persons may solicit funds as provided in section 1 of this Act:
33	1. Law enforcement officers. Law enforcement officers,
35	with the consent of the chief administrator of the law enforcement agency employing those officers; and -
37	2. Any other person. Any other person, with the consent of
39	the Maine Chiefs of Police Association.
41	No law enforcement officer may solicit funds as provided by section 1 of this Act while in uniform. The chief administrator
43	of each law enforcement agency shall provide the Maine Chiefs of Police Association with a list of those law enforcement officers
45	the chief administrator has authorized to solicit funds as provided by section 1 of this Act. The Maine Chiefs of Police
47	Association shall maintain a list of those authorized to solicit funds as provided by section 1 of this Act.

The Maine Chiefs of Police Association shall be responsible for coordinating the collection, 3 management and expenditure of all funds collected pursuant to section 1 of this Act. 5 Sec. 4. Monetary limit. 7 The aggregate amount collected pursuant to section 1 of this Act may not exceed \$150,000.' 9 11 STATEMENT OF FACT 13 The amendment changes the bill in the following ways: A maximum of \$150,000 may be collected through 15 1. solicitation. 17 Solicitation for funds for the memorial is limited to 2. 19 one year. 21 The Maine Chiefs of Police Association is responsible 3. for coordinating the fund raising and the construction effort. 23 4. A law enforcement officer must obtain the consent of the 25 chief administrator of the law enforcement agency employing that officer to be authorized to solicit. 27 Any other person may solicit for the memorial only with 5. the approval of the Maine Chiefs of Police Association. 29 31 6. The Maine Chiefs of Police Association shall maintain a record of those authorized to solicit funds for the memorial. 33 7. This legislation will become an unallocated private and 35 special law.
