COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 197, L.D. 277, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Number of Moose Permits Issued to Residents"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Increase the Number of Moose Permits Issued'

Further amend the bill in subsection 4, in the 4th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~10% 100~~" and inserting in its place the following: '10%'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this legislation will result in an increase in dedicated revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in the amount of \$21,250 for fiscal year 1990-91. This revenue will be derived from the proposed increase in moose hunting permits.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the title and deletes that portion of the bill which would freeze the number of nonresident permits at 100. Instead, this amendment would continue the current practice of allowing up to 10% of the total number of permits issued to be nonresident and alien permits. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
