In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved. 25 FISCAL NOTE 27 29 The Public Utilities Commission will be able to absorb the minor additional burden of additional approvals within the 31 existing budgeted resources.' 33 STATEMENT OF FACT 35 The amendment makes additional clarifications and minor changes to the law governing prior approval by the Public Utilities Commission of certain electric utility transmission 37 39 line construction projects as follows: 41 It adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause in 1. order for the new requirements to be in effect for the next 43 transmission line projects. 45 2. The amendment replaces the word "carrying" to "operating at" in 4 places to make clear that the regulations apply to the 47 designed capacity of the line and not what a utility may initially decide to transmit over the line. 49

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 3. It adds the clarification that new requirements for minor transmission line construction projects in section 4 of the bill supersede the general requirements.
4. It specifies that the fee for a petition to construct a transmission line is 4/100 of 1%.
5. It adds a new provision allowing the commission to waive the requirement of a 2-month notice before filing a petition.
6. It adds a fiscal note.
