IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Allow Holders of Maine Hunting Licenses to Hunt on Sunday during Hunting Season.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:
5	
7	4. Hunting on Sunday. A person is guilty of hunting or Sunday if he <u>that person</u> hunts wild animals or wild birds or Sunday, except as provided in section 7457.
9	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶A, as amended by PL 1981, c.
11	414, §31, is further amended to read:
13	A. There shall be an open season on deer in each calendar year in all counties of the State from the 5th Monday
15	preceding Thanksgiving to November 30th.
17	Persons holding a resident hunting license may hunt deer or any Sunday within the open season set out in this paragraph.

21	STATEMENT OF FACT
23	This bill allows Maine residents to hunt deer on Sundays during the regular open season on deer.
