COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 220, L.D. 300, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Maine Used Car Information Laws"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§1472." in the first paragraph in the 8th to 10th lines (page 1, lines 15 to 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "lessee, to an employee of the lessee or to a purchaser or other transferee obtained by a lessee" and inserting in its place the following: 'lessee or to an employee of the lessee'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of the original bill was to remove sales transactions involving a vehicle lessor or lessee from having to abide by the Maine used car information laws, since it is assumed that the lessee has the knowledge of the vehicle that the used car buyer does not.

This amendment removes the exemption of the original bill that includes sales or transfers to 3rd parties obtained by the lessee, since it was felt that they might not have the same knowledge of the vehicle that the lessee had and should have the normal protection of used car laws.
