The increases in dedicated revenue are attributable to the State Board of Funeral Service, \$800 in each fiscal year; the Board of Respiratory Care Practitioners, \$2,000 in each fiscal year; and the Board of Licensure of Railroad Personnel. Since no General Fund revenues were budgeted for the Board of Licensure of Railroad Personnel, the transition to a dedicated revenue program will not result in a loss of General Fund revenues.' '
