An Act to Amend the Composition of House District 48 and House District 49.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **21-A MRSA §1201, sub-§5, District Number 48 and District Number**
49, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, §6, are amended to read:

6 District Number 48, consisting of the municipalities of
7 Newfield and Parsonsfield in York County, and the
8 municipalities of Brownfield, Denmark, Fryeburg, Porter,
9 Stoneham Lovell and Stow in Oxford County.

11 District Number 49, consisting of the municipalities of
12 Bethel, Byron, Gilead, Hanover, Lincoln Plantation, Levell
13 Stoneham, Magalloway Plantation, Newry, Upton, Waterford,
14 the unorganized territories of South Oxford County and North
15 Oxford County in Oxford County the municipalities of Avon,
16 Rangeley, Rangeley Plantation, Sandy River Plantation and
17 Weld, and the unorganized territories of West Central
18 Franklin County in Franklin County.
