17	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its
19	place the following:
21	' 28-A MRSA §4, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:
23	A. Licensees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the
25	hours of 6 a.m. and 12-noon <u>11 a.m.</u> .
27	FISCAL NOTE
29	The increase in the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages may
31	increase undedicated General Fund revenue. This increase will not be significant.'

35	STATEMENT OF FACT
37	The amendment changes the bill in 2 ways. First, the amendment strikes that part of the bill which would allow sales
39	of alochol on Memorial Day before noon. Second, the amendment allows Sunday sales of alcohol to begin at 11 a.m., rather than
41	12 noon, as in current law.
43	The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
