COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 228, L.D. 312, Bill, "An Act to Establish Consistent Daily Hours for the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'28-A MRSA §4, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

A. Licensees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the hours of 6 a.m. and ~~12 noon~~ 11 a.m.

FISCAL NOTE

The increase in the hours of sale of alcoholic beverages may increase undedicated General Fund revenue. This increase will not be significant.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment changes the bill in 2 ways. First, the amendment strikes that part of the bill which would allow sales of alcohol on Memorial Day before noon. Second, the amendment allows Sunday sales of alcohol to begin at 11 a.m., rather than 12 noon, as in current law.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
