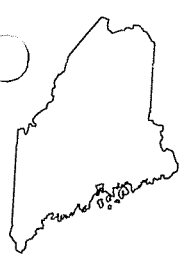

**An Act to Expand the Types of Medication Included in the Elderly
Low-cost Drug Program.**



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §254, 2nd ¶,** as enacted by PL 1987, c. 746, is
5 amended to read:

7 In any year in which this program is conducted, it shall
9 also include antiarthritic drugs and the amount that a recipient
11 pays toward the cost of any such covered purchase shall be \$10.

13 **Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §254,** as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c.
15 746, is amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph
17 to read:

19 In any year in which this program is conducted, it shall
21 include anticoagulant drugs and the amount that a recipient pays
23 toward the cost of any such covered purchase shall be \$1.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill includes anticoagulant drugs in the elderly
low-cost drug program. Participants will contribute \$1 toward
the purchase price of these drugs.
