COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 168, L.D. 325, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Compensation of the Board of Dental Examiners and Secretary-Treasurer of the Board"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out everything after the amending clause (page 1, lines 6 and 7 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'10. Board of Dental Examiners \$35/Day 32 MRSA §1071 §1072
legislative
per diem
secretary-
treasurer,
as determined
by board'

Further amend the bill in section 3, in the 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines 24 and 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "not to exceed \$2,500 \$3,600" and inserting in its place the following: '~~not to exceed~~-\$2,500'

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, members of the Board of Dental Examiners are paid a \$35 per diem and the board's secretary-treasurer is paid a salary of \$2,500.

The original bill proposed raising the per diem to \$125 and the secretary-treasurer's salary to \$3,600. This amendment sets the per diem at the legislative per diem and allows the board to determine the salary of the secretary-treasurer.
