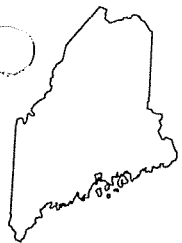

An Act to Increase the Compensation of the Board of Dental Examiners and  
Secretary-Treasurer of the Board.

---



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-A, sub-§10, as enacted by PL 1987, c.  
786, §5, is amended to read:

5 10. Board of Dental \$35/Day 32 MRSA §1071  
7 Examiners \$125/Day

9 Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1071, first ¶, as amended by PL 1983, c. 812,  
§200, is further amended to read:

11 The Board of Dental Examiners, established by Title 5,  
13 section 12004 12004-A, subsection 1 10, and in this chapter  
called the "board," shall consist of 7 members, appointed by the  
15 Governor as follows: Five five members of the dental profession,  
one dental hygienist and one representative of the public.

17 Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §1072, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1975, c. 484,  
19 §2, is further amended to read:

21 The secretary-treasurer shall receive all fees, charges and  
assessments payable to the board and account for and pay over the  
23 same according to law. The ~~secretary~~ secretary-treasurer shall  
receive an annual salary to be fixed by the board not to exceed  
25 \$2,500 \$3,600, which shall be received by ~~him~~ the  
secretary-treasurer in lieu of a per diem compensation. The  
27 ~~secretary~~ secretary-treasurer shall be paid his necessary  
expenses incurred in the discharge of his the  
29 secretary-treasurer's official duties, including clerical and  
stenographic assistance, printing and postage. ~~Such~~ The salary  
31 and allowance for expenses shall be certified by the president of  
the board.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

39 This bill raises the per diem of the Board of Dental  
Examiners from \$35 to \$125 a day and the compensation of the  
41 secretary-treasurer of the board from \$2,500 to \$3,600 per year.
