SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 179, L.D. 336, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Reporting Deadline of the Commission to Implement the Computerization of Criminal History Record Information"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'P&SL 1987, c. 152, §1, last sentence is amended to read:

The commission shall present its final report and recommendations, together with any recommended legislation, to the First Regular Session of the ~~114th~~ 115th Legislature by June ~~1, 1989~~ March 1, 1991.


Further amend the bill by inserting after the emergency clause and before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

There is currently a balance available to the Commission to Implement the Computerization of Criminal History Record Information to fund activities into the next biennium. If additional funds are required, an additional request shall be presented to the Legislature.'
