COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 181, L.D. 338, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Costs Associated with the Purchase of Land by School Administrative Units"

Amend the bill by adding before the statement of fact the following:

'C. Purchase of land made in accordance with this section must be approved:

(1) By the legislative body of the school administrative unit; and

(2) By the commissioner, under rules to be adopted for this purpose.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will result in an increase of general purpose aid for local schools. Neither the amount nor the timing of the additional General Fund appropriations required may be determined at this time since no data on these land purchases are readily available.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a process for the approval of land purchases by school administrative units and to add a fiscal note to the bill.
