An Act to Provide More Legislative Oversight of Agency Rulemaking.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 5 MRSA §8053-A, as amended by PL 1987, c. 402, Pt. A, §§60
5 and 61, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

7 §8053-A. Legislative review

9 1. Submission of rules and fact sheets to the Legislature.

11 At the time of giving notice of rulemaking under section 8053 or
13 within 10 days following the adoption of an emergency rule, the
15 agency shall provide copies of the proposed rule to the director
17 of the office of the Legislature which reviews proposed agency
19 rules and may be referred to as the legislative office on rules.
21 In addition to providing the director of this office with
23 sufficient copies of a proposed rule for each member of the
25 appropriate committee or committees, the agency shall provide to
27 the director sufficient copies of a fact sheet providing:

19 A. A citation of the statutory authority for the adoption
21 of the rule;

23 B. A concise statement of the principal reasons for the
25 rule;

27 C. An analysis of the rule; and

29 D. An estimated fiscal impact of the rule.

31 2. Review of rules. The director of the legislative office
33 on rules shall review each rule with respect to:

35 A. Clarity;

37 B. Sufficient statutory justification for the rule;

39 C. Sufficient statutory standards for the rule;

41 D. Whether the rule achieves the purpose for which it is
43 proposed; and

45 E. How well the proposed rule achieves the purpose.

47 Following the director's review of the rule, the director shall
49 prepare a statement concisely stating the findings with respect
51 to the review criteria of this subsection. A copy of this
53 statement shall be sent to the agency proposing the rule. In
55 addition, a copy of the statement shall accompany the proposed
57 rule and fact sheet sent to each Legislator of the appropriate
59 committee as provided in subsection 3.
