17	Amend the bill in subsection 1-A in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the word and punctuation
19	" <u>plastic.</u> " the following:
21	'For the purposes of this subsection, the term, "beverage stirrer," is a device which is designed solely for the purpose of
23	mixing liquids intended for internal human consumption in single serving containers.'

27	Further amend the bill by adding before the statement of fact the following:
29	'FISCAL NOTE
31	Because the amount of plastic stirrers used by the State and State institutions is minimal, this bill to prohibit the use of
33	these stirrers will not increase costs significantly. The transition from plastic to wood stirrers or the expanded use of
35	spoons can be implemented within existing budgeted resources.'
37	Statement of Fact

• 41	The purpose of this amendment is to provide a definition of the term, "beverage stirrer". It is the intent of the
43	Legislature that this definition not include spoons or any other eating utensil which is normally used for more purposes than
45	stirring beverages.
