HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 239, L.D. 351, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit the Use of Plastic Beverage Stirrers in State Facilities"

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect January 1, 1990.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds an effective date of January 1, 1990 to the bill to correspond with the effective date of the existing law governing nondegradable food and beverage containers.
