COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 356, Bill, "An Act to Make Additional Allocations from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1990"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Make Additional Allocations from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1989 and June 30, 1990'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Allocation of Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund. The Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund shall be allocated as designated in the following schedule.
