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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill reallocates funds from the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 116, subsection 5. Reallocated by the Legislature from fiscal year 1986-87 to fiscal year 1988-89 was \$300,472 for the purchase of a new computer system. Due to unforeseen delays these funds will not be expended in fiscal year 1988-89 and must be reallocated to fiscal year 1989-90. This bill also reallocates \$115,155 brought forward from fiscal year 1987-88 to fiscal year 1989-90 for custom software development associated with the computer system.
