An Act to Provide Continuity in the Retirement Laws.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

_	receives a retirement benefit from the Maine State Retirement
7 -	System, has at least 10 years of creditable service as a teacher, as defined by Title 5, section 17001, subsection 42, and meets
9	the eligibility requirements for participation as a dependent in
-	a group plan governing teachers shall be eligible for group
11	accident and sickness or health insurance.

17	This bill broadens the eligibility requirements for the 15% state payment of retired teacher group health insurance to
19	include dependents of eligible participants if those dependents have at least 10 years of creditable service as teachers and
21	receive retirement benefits from the Maine State Retirement System.
