STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Mandate Disclosure of Rustproofing of Motor Vehicles.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §2611 is enacted to read:

5 <u>§2611. Rustproofing</u>

Any person who rustproofs a car in this State or who sells or offers a car for sale in this State which the seller or offeror claims has been rustproofed shall provide the owner or offeree with the following information:

 Type. The type and method of rustproofing used
including at least the concentration of rustproofing material, the applicator, the location at which the rustproofing was
completed, the warranty if applicable; and

17 2. Scope. How much and which parts of the car are rustproofed. Rustproofing must be visible upon inspection by the consumer or buyer or a schematic of the rustproofing must be provided.

A person who willfully violates this section shall be 23 punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment of not more than 6 months, or both. 25

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require anyone who rustproofs 31 a car or sells a car which has been rustproofed to inform the owner or buyer as to what type of rustproofing was used and how 33 much of the car has been rustproofed.
