As a result, additional revenue to the General Fund, 26 estimated to be \$250,000 to \$500,000 annually, would be generated due to increased Medicaid reimbursement.' 28 STATEMENT OF FACT 30 32 This amendment makes changes to the original bill to account for changes in reimbursement procedures adopted by the department since the First Regular Session of the 114th Legislature. Many 34 facilities now have a variable per diem rate inadequate to meet 36 necessary and reasonable costs as a result of these changes. This amendment gives intermediate care facilities for the 38 mentally retarded a one-time opportunity to rebase their per diem rate to these actual reasonable costs. It also requires the 40 department to address several specific cost categories when 42 determine each facility's rate. 44 This amendment also adds a fiscal note, an appropriation and an allocation to the bill.
