HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 253,
L.D. 365, Bill, "An Act to Allow a Student an Option in
Biological Dissection"

Amend the amendment by inserting before the statement of
fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill does not require, but may result in additional
expenditures by local school units. Therefore, the State is not
required to pay 100% of those costs during the first 2 years
according to the State mandate law. However, the State may incur
additional school subsidy expenses beginning in fiscal year
1991-92. The Department of Educational and Cultural Services
will be able to absorb the additional costs of rulemaking and the
report within existing budgeted resources.

This bill also establishes the Biological Dissection Options
Fund, a dedicated revenue account. No General Fund
appropriations are currently requested to support the fund.
Other sources of dedicated revenue cannot be identified at this
time. When revenues are received in this account, expenditures
will have to be authorized by financial order.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to add a fiscal note to the
bill.
