COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 254, L.D. 366, Bill, "An Act to Allow Municipalities to Withhold Business Licenses under Some Circumstances"

Amend the bill in that part designated "Sec. 3-A." by inserting at the end the following:

'No municipality may refuse to issue a license because of an applicant's delinquency during the pendency of any request for an abatement from or an appeal of the tax assessment which is claimed to be delinquent.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment prevents a municipality from refusing to issue a license to an applicant if the applicant has filed an appeal of the personal property tax assessment which is claimed to be delinquent.
