IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Allow Municipalities to Withhold Business Licenses under Some Circumstances.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	P&SL 1961, c. 176, §3-A is enacted to read:
5	Sec. 3-A. Personal property tax delinquency. Any municipality with an ordinance enacted under the authority of
7	this chapter may refuse to issue or renew a license when the applicant is delinquent in paying any personal property tax
9	assessed by the municipality.

13	STATEMENT OF FACT
15	This bill permits the municipalities authorized under Private and Special Law 1961, chapter 176, to refuse to issue or
17	renew a license for businesses which are subject to a licensing ordinance if the business is delinquent in paying personal
19	property taxes. This bill allocates this authority to Private and Special Law 1961, chapter 176, which establishes the
21	licensing ordinance for those towns.
