COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 258, L.D. 370, Bill, "An Act to Promote Effective Identification of Minors"

Amend the bill in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "color" the following: 'code'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment maintains the purpose of the bill to require distinctive drivers' licenses for persons under age 21. This amendment modifies the bill to allow the use of a distinctive colored bar on the license rather than requiring the complete document to be colored. This continues present practice.
