An Act to Promote Effective Identification of Minors.

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **29 MRSA §540-A, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987,**  
5 **c. 791, §4, is amended to read:**

7 **1. Under 21 years of age. The Secretary of State shall**  
9 **provide that licenses issued to persons under 21 years of age be**  
11 **distinctive, ~~either~~ by being printed with a different color than**  
13 **~~for those issued to persons 21 years of age or older or by some~~**  
15 **~~other appropriate distinguishing mark or code.~~**

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 **This bill requires that a distinctively different colored**  
17 **drivers license be issued to those under the age of 21 for the**  
19 **purpose of aiding clerks, cashiers, law enforcement personnel and**  
21 **others involved in checking identification.**
