5	5. Driver failure to yield right-of-way. A driver who
	fails to yield the right of way as required in subsection 1

13	The purpose of this bill is to clarify that a driver of a motor vehicle who fails to yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian
15	commits a traffic infraction for which the driver may be fined
	from \$25 to \$250 in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section
