An Act to Provide that Medical Information in the Files of the Maine
State Retirement System is not Public Information.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **5 MRSA §17057 is enacted to read:**

5 **§17057. Medical information not public record**

7 Medical information of any kind in the possession of the
9 retirement system, including information pertaining to diagnosis
11 or treatment of mental or emotional disorders, shall be
13 confidential and not open to public inspection and shall not be
15 "public records" as defined in Title 1, section 402, subsection
17 3. Records containing medical information may be examined by the
19 employee to whom they relate when the examination is permitted or
21 required by law.

17 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

19 This bill requires that the Maine State Retirement System
21 treat medical information of any kind that is in its possession
23 as confidential information. The language in this bill is based
upon the language which provides that medical information in the
records of the Bureau of Human Resources be confidential.
