STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Concerning Agency Liquor Store Pricing.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

28-A MRSA §606, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1987, c. 342, §29, is further amended to read:

4. Discount for agency liquor stores. The commission shall sell spirits to agency liquor stores for a price of 8% <u>10%</u> less than the real price established for the state liquor stores.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require the State Liquor Commission to sell stock to agency stores at 10% below the price established for state liquor stores. This change will allow agency liquor stores to mark up their stock 10% without exceeding the price charged for an item by state liquor stores.

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
