An Act Concerning the Operation of Motor Vehicles on Private Lands.



3	29 MRSA §900-B is enacted to read:
5	<u>§900-B. Operating on land of another</u>
7	1. Permission necessary. Except in an emergency, no person may operate a motor vehicle on the land of another without first
9	obtaining the landowner's permission.
11	2. Violation. A violation of this section is a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor more
13	than \$500 may be adjudged, of which not more than \$50 may be suspended.

17	STATEMENT OF FACT
19	
21	This bill prohibits the operation of a motor vehicle on the land of another without the permission of the landowner. It also establishes a civil forfeiture of \$100 to \$500 for each violation.
