NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Concerning the Operation of Motor Vehicles on Private Lands.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **29 MRSA §900-B** is enacted to read:

5 **§900-B. Operating on land of another**

7 **1. Permission necessary.** Except in an emergency, no person
9 may operate a motor vehicle on the land of another without first
10 obtaining the landowner's permission.

11 **2. Violation.** A violation of this section is a civil
12 violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor more
13 than \$500 may be adjudged, of which not more than \$50 may be
14 suspended.

STATEMENT OF FACT

21 This bill prohibits the operation of a motor vehicle on the
22 land of another without the permission of the landowner. It also
23 establishes a civil forfeiture of \$100 to \$500 for each violation.
