1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§65 is enacted to read:

5 65. Organizations providing certain services for the  
7 hearing impaired. Sales to incorporated nonprofit organizations  
9 whose primary purposes are to promote public understanding of  
11 hearing impairment and to assist the hearing impaired through the  
dissemination of information about hearing impairment to the  
general public and referral to and coordination of community  
resources available to the hearing impaired.

17 The purpose of this bill is to support through a sales tax  
19 exemption the efforts of those nonprofit corporations whose

of the hearing impaired through the dissemination of information
