SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 280, L.D. 392, Bill, "An Act to Increase Displaced Homemakers Program Funding to Continue Rural Outreach, Employment and Training and Support Services for Maine Displaced Homemakers"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
