An Act to Ensure Medicare Affordability.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	36 MRSA §5219-C is enacted to read:
5	<u>§5219-C. Medicare catastrophic coverage credit</u>
7	For a taxable year, beginning in 1989, a taxpayer who is assessed a surcharge under the federal Medicare Catastrophic
9	Coverage Act of 1988 shall be allowed a credit against the tax otherwise due under this Part equal to the amount of the
11	surcharge. The following individuals are eligible for the tax credit under this section:
