HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 293, L.D. 405, Bill, "An Act to Allow 15-year-olds to be Employed in Kitchen and Common Areas in Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Inns with less than 20 Rooms"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act Regarding the Employment of 15-year-olds in Public Accommodations for Lodging'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the first paragraph after the amending clause (page 1, lines 21 to 23 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Notwithstanding this section, minors who are 15 years of age or older may be employed in kitchens, dining rooms, lobbies and offices of public accommodations for lodging during the period from June 15th to Labor Day.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to allow minors 15 years of age or older to work in the kitchens, dining rooms, lobbies or offices of public accommodations for lodging regardless of the number of rooms during the period from June 15th to Labor Day.
