HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 293, L.D. 405, Bill, "An Act to Allow 15-year-olds to be Employed in Kitchen and Common Areas in Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Inns with less than 20 Rooms"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664, last ¶, as amended by PL 1969, c. 504, §43, is further amended to read:

Employees who are under the age of 19 and are regularly enrolled in an educational institution or are on vacation therefrom may be paid a rate of not less than 75% of the applicable minimum wage rate required for other employees in the same occupation, except that minors employed in any hotel, motel, inn or lodginghouse shall not be paid less than 100% of the applicable minimum wage rate.

Further amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 2.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment exempts minors employed in the hospitality industry from the student minimum wage.
