An Act to Allow 15-year-olds to be Employed in Kitchen and Common Areas in Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Inns with less than 20 Rooms.

(EMERGENCY)



1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3	as emergencies; and
5	Whereas, many small inns and bed and breakfast establishments have faced great difficulty in hiring sufficient
7	members of staff for the summer tourist season, and there are minors who are interested in summer employment; and
9	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
11	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
13	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
15	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
