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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 296, L.D. 408, Bill, "An Act to Extend Reporting Deadlines of the Therapeutic Pharmaceutical Monitoring Panel"

Amend the bill by striking out the 2nd paragraph of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 5 to 7 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Whereas, this legislation is necessary so that the requirement for the Therapeutic Pharmaceutical Monitoring Panel to report by a certain date will be repealed before the reporting date takes effect; and'

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Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

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- '32 MRSA §2428, sub-§6, as amended by PL 1987, c. 586, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 6. Report. The panel shall prepare reports summarizing the findings of the panel regarding the use of therapeutic pharmaceutical agents.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment deletes the requirement that the Therapeutic

Pharmaceutical Monitoring Panel submit reports to the Governor,
the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, the State

Board of Optometry and the State Board of Registration in
Medicine. It also removes the requirement that the panel make
these reports by certain dates.
