An Act Concerning Voter Residency Requirements.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	21-A MRSA §111, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1987, c. 188, §1, is further amended to read:

	3. Residence. He <u>The person</u> must have established and
7	maintain maintained a voting residence in that municipality for 3
	consecutive months preceding the election.
9	STATEMENT OF FACT

	The purpose of this bill is to require 3 months' residency
13	in a municipality before one is eligible to vote in that municipality. This change would make the term of residency
15	required for voting purposes the same as that required to obtain a resident hunting license.
