STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Adjust the Municipal Salt and Sand Storage Facility Cost-sharing Formula. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 23 MRSA §1851, first ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 769, Pt. A, $\S85$, and c. 793, Pt. A, $\S4$, is repealed and the following enacted 5 in its place:

7 The department may administer funds for the construction of municipal or county salt and sand storage facilities in order to 9 reduce salt pollution of ground and surface waters. Any bonds issued under this section shall be paid for out of the Highway 11 Fund. In administering these funds, the department shall provide reimbursement to municipal and county governmental entities for 13 approved projects according to the order of priority established biennially by the Department of Environmental Protection.

The base formula for determining the formula for allocating 17 funds is 1.25 times the ratio of miles of state and state-aid roads maintained for winter use, as described in sections 1001 19 and 1003, to all miles maintained for winter use by the municipality, guasi-municipal agency or county.

If the sum of the amount reimbursed under section 1852 and 23 the amount that would be reimbursed using the base formula is \$50,000 or less, the formula for allocating funds is 1.35 times 25 the ratio of miles of state and state-aid roads maintained for winter use, as described in sections 1001 and 1003, to all miles 27 maintained for winter use by the municipality, quasi-municipal agency or county.

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If the sum of the amount reimbursed under section 1852 and 31 the amount that would be reimbursed using the base formula is over \$50,000, the formula for allocating funds is 1.15 times the 33 ratio of miles of state and state-aid roads maintained for winter use, as described in sections 1001 and 1003, to all miles 35 maintained for winter use by the municipality, quasi-municipal agency or county.

The department shall establish guidelines to reimburse 39 eligible local government entities in a consistent and timely manner.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

45 This bill resolves a conflict by incorporating the changes made by 2 public laws. It also changes the formula for 47 allocating funds to municipalities for the construction of salt and sand storage facilities to help offset the initial cost of 49 construction common to all municipalities.
