An Act to Require Health and Safety Disclaimers on Television and Print Media Alcohol Advertisements.



Т	be it enacted by the a copie of the State of Manie as follows.
3	28-A MRSA §715 is enacted to read:
5	§715. Disclaimers on alcohol advertisements
7	1. Protection of public health and safety. The Legislature intends to exercise the police power of the State to protect the
9	health and safety of Maine citizens and to promote the general welfare by alerting the public to the health and safety risks
11	associated with the consumption of alcohol.
13	2. Disclaimers required. A disclaimer that states the health and safety risks of alcohol consumption shall appear or
15	every advertisement for the sale of alcoholic beverages in this State, including, but not limited to, advertisements or
17	television and radio and in all print media.
19	3. Form of disclaimer. The Department of Human Services, in conjunction with the Office of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse
21	Prevention, shall by rules promulgated in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, develop
23	one or more forms of disclaimers that state the health and safety risks of alcohol consumption.
