21	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the
23	enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:
25	'19 MRSA §722-A, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
27	6. Omitted property. If a final divorce decree fails to
29	set apart or divide marital property over which the court had jurisdiction, the omitted property is deemed held by both parties
31	as tenants in common. On the motion of either party, which may be made at any time, the court may partition the omitted property
33	between the parties, as justice may require.'
