An Act to Reduce the Expense of the Legislative Process by Shortening the Length of Legislative Sessions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 MRSA $\S 2$, 2nd \P , as amended by PL 1985, c. 166, is further amended to read:

The first regular session of the Legislature, -- after - itseenvening, shall adjourn no later than the 3rd-Wednesday-in-June-2nd Wednesday in April and the 2nd regular session of the Legislature shall adjourn no later than the 3rd-Wednesday-in April first Wednesday in March. The Legislature, in case of emergency, may by a vote of 2/3 of the members of each House present and voting, extend the date for adjournment for the first or 2nd regular session by no more than 5 legislative days, and in case of further emergency, may by a vote of 2/3 of the members of each House present and voting, further extend the date for adjournment by 5 additional legislative days. The times for adjournment for the first and 2nd regular sessions may also be extended for one additional legislative day for the purpose of considering possible objections of the Governor to any bill or resolution presented to him the Governor by the Legislature under the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 2. The date for cloture for the first regular session shall be the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December.

This bill shortens the legislative sessions. The first regular session will adjourn no later than the 2nd Wednesday in April and the 2nd regular session will adjourn no later than the first Wednesday in March. This will reduce the length of the sessions by roughly 1/3 and reduce the budget required by the current length of the sessions. In addition, this bill sets cloture date as the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December for the first regular session.
