1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	7 MRSA §1008-I is enacted to read:
5	§1008-I. Barrel replaced by hundredweight as a measure
7	Buyers and sellers of potatoes may not use a barrel as a unit of measure for potatoes. All measures of potatoes must be
9	in pounds.

13	STATEMENT OF FACT
15	This bill replaces the barrel as a measure for potatoes. It is the intent of the bill that buyers and sellers would use
17	pounds or hundredweight as a unit of measure in their transactions and reports.
