An Act to Eliminate the Barrel as the Unit Measure of Buyers and Sellers of Potatoes.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 7 MRSA §1008-I is enacted to read:

5 §1008-I. Barrel replaced by hundredweight as a measure

7 Buyers and sellers of potatoes may not use a barrel as a
9 unit of measure for potatoes. All measures of potatoes must be
in pounds.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill replaces the barrel as a measure for potatoes. It is the intent of the bill that buyers and sellers would use pounds or hundredweight as a unit of measure in their transactions and reports.
