HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 196,  
L.D. 444, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Discrimination Against  
Persons with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus for Purposes of  
Insurance Coverage"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 6th  
line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the  
following: "Syndrome." and inserting in its place the  
following: 'Syndrome or AIDS, AIDS Related Complex (ARC) or HIV  
related diseases'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment makes a technical change to clarify that  
section 2 of the amendment protects persons who have AIDS Related  
Complex (ARC) and HIV related diseases from unfair discrimination  
by insurers. Section 2 of the amendment inadvertently failed to  
include reference to ARC or HIV related diseases, although they  
are included in the protections provided in every other section  
of the amendment.
