26	Committee on Housing and Economic Development, the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation and the Office of the Executive Director of
28	the Legislative Council by January 1, 1991 on options for creating affordable rental housing that offer the greatest
30	potential for success. The Maine State Housing Authority shall consider both tax-based incentives and other incentives.'

34	Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.
36 38	Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking out all of the 7th and 8th lines (page 13, lines 33 and 34 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:
